- VIII. <u>Late Work:</u> Late homework is accepted. However, you will lose 5 points for each day that the homework is late. Homework cannot be submitted after the grading period ends. Hence, please submit your homework on-time. Furthermore, Mendez Fundamental Intermediate has consequences for failing to complete assignments.
 - IX. Re-Take Assessments: You can retake quizzes and tests in which you earned a D or an F. The retake quizzes and tests are to be completed within one week of receiving the graded quiz or test. You need to contact me and make arrangements for a retake of the quiz or test.
 - Step 1: The student needs to study the material again.
 - <u>■ NOTE</u>: Students are responsible for organizing their binder and taking good notes so that they are prepared for quizzes and tests. I will model how notes are to be organized and how to master helpful test-taking tips throughout the school year.
 - o <u>Step 2:</u> The new grade for the retake will replace the original assessment grade/score.
