

# **Cell phones Headphones Earbuds Policy**



#### SADDLEBACK HIGH SCHOOL **Roadrunner Nation Student Cell Phone Policy**



Cell phones are to be put away during class hours, including time out of the classroom on a hall pass, and during ALL school and state testing. Students will not be allowed to use cell phones during class time. School authorities may confiscated cell phones at any time for failure to follow school policy. Parents and students will sign understanding of the cell phone policy annually.

Students will place their cell phones and earbuds (including Airbuds and Ipods) in Teacher Designated Storage Area upon entering classroom.

# **Dress Code** - What's acceptable & What's not?

#### Hats / Caps/Beanies

- Only **Saddleback hats** are allowed on campus
- Can only be worn outdoor (not in buildings or classrooms)

No **Hoodies** worn over head except when weather permits (outdoors)

Violation of school dress code can lead to consequences, including parent conference, issuing of spirit wear, detention, campus beautification, Saturday School, or other consequences issued by admin.

Students who violate dress code will be asked to change/cover or their parent will be called to bring a new shirt.












