

# From the Superintendent's Desk

Weekly Update From Supt. Jerry Almendarez

**February 7, 2022** 



### Dear SAUSD community,

I continue to remain encouraged by the sharp decrease in our COVID-19 positive cases in our schools since the surge following the winter break. As of last Friday, we have seen an 85% decrease in the number of COVID-19 positive cases among students compared to the second week of January, the peak of the surge.

We have also seen a 7 decrease over the same time in the number of students absent because of guarantine or because they are COVID-19 positive. These are strong indicators that we continue in the right direction.

There has been some discussion across the region and state regarding easing restrictions for schools as our rates continue to fall. This includes possible changes to masking policies in schools. At this point, SAUSD continues to follow all masking guidelines provided by healthcare agencies. SAUSD will only change these guidelines if local and state health experts indicate this is a safe path to follow. We will provide updates as they become available.
